Listed below are typical disabilities that often result in eligibility for Vocational Rehabilitation services.

1. Allergies/Asthma (Severe- Evidence of 3 episodic attacks during the last year)
2. Arthritis
3. Anxiety
4. Autism
5. Bipolar disorder
6. Blindness
7. Cancer (on going limiting side effects)
8. Cardiovascular/Pulmonary Diseases
9. Cerebral palsy
10. Substance use Disorder
11. Deafness
12. Diabetes (Type 1 or Type 2)
13. Epilepsy
14. Gastrointestinal Disorders
15. Hearing Loss of 26-55 dbs loss
16. Heart Conditions (Class III-C or worse)
17. Impairments requiring the use of a wheelchair
18. Infectious Disease
19. Intellectual disability/Specific Learning Disability
20. Major depression
21. Missing limbs or partially missing limbs
22. Morbid Obesity (must exceed normal weight by 100lbs)
23. Muscular dystrophy
24. Neurological Disorders (i.e. Spina Bifida, Multiple Sclerosis, Poliomyelitis, Amyotrophic lateral sclerosis)
25. Obsessive compulsive disorder
26. Orthopedic Disorders (Low back, Knee, Etc.)
27. Post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD)
28. Renal Disorders
29. Schizophrenia
30. Speech Defect
31. Strokes
32. Traumatic Brain Injury or acquired brain injury
33. Vascular Disorders
34. Visual (Severely reduced acuity or eye pathology)
